Our support can be accessed by any young person aged 5 - 19\* years old who are thinking of using drugs/alcohol, already using drugs/alcohol or affected by a parent or carers drug/alcohol use.

Anyone can refer to our service and all young people who access our service are allocated to a keyworker, assessed and supported in creating and reviewing a person-centered careplan.
