

DT Curriculum Map – 2020-2021

A thorough risk assessment has been carried out for all areas within the DT curriculum. With this in mind, the units under: 'Food and Nutrition' have been amended so that no cooking will take place using our design room facilities such as the cookers. However, to avoid 'gaps' in pupils learning, food preparation skills will take place within classrooms. Similarly, for the 'Structures' unit, pupils will no longer need to bring in scrap material from home, all resources will be provided by the school. Finally, pupils will continue to have a rich learning experience within DT, using equipment that has been thoroughly sanitised or quarantined for three days to ensure it is safe to use.
