
Dear Parents/Carers.

During the last 24 hours additional information has been shared with schools which outlines the increased risks observed since the discovery of a new strain of COVID-19.

After much consideration, we have taken the decision not to re-open to pupils on Tuesday unless they are classed as vulnerable or a parent is a key worker. Further details of these categories can be found towards the end of this letter.

The safety of your children, family and school staff has led all key decisions made since the beginning of the pandemic. Thank you for the support you have given the school during this difficult time and I apologise for the disruption the decision, not to re-open, will undoubtedly cause some of you. I am also acutely aware that the school's decision comes at a very late stage in the school holidays.

As you can see from the graphics below, Putnoe is listed as being an area with one of the highest infection rates in Bedford Borough. The number of cases in Bedford Borough has soared in the last few weeks and are currently at a very concerning level.
