Barriers To Future Attainment

1. Attainment and progress, amplified by the school closure from March 2020
2. Language development, especially in the Early Years and Key Stage 1
3. Care, guidance and support, including low parental engagement and persistent absenteeism

Desired Outcomes

1. Remove barriers to pupils' language development so reading, writing and maths attainment is in-line with national data at Key Stage 1 and 2 in 2019
2. Gaps in attainment, exacerbated by the school closure in Summer 2020, are closed
3. Pupils are given the opportunity to have access to wider-curriculum opportunities and these achievements are shared
