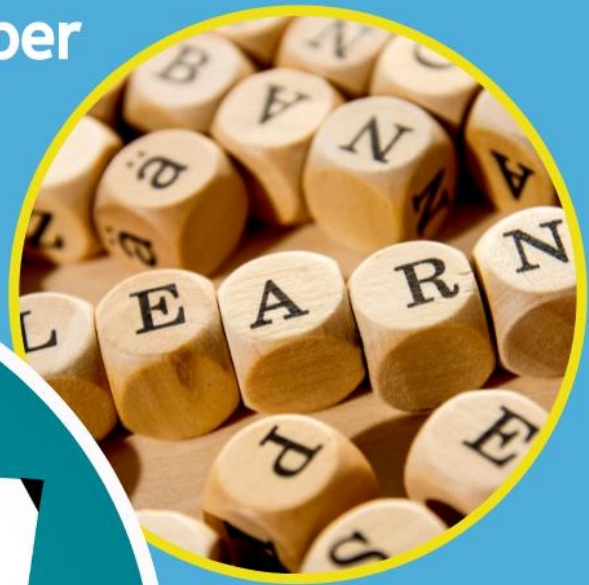

- Be aware of the resources available for parents

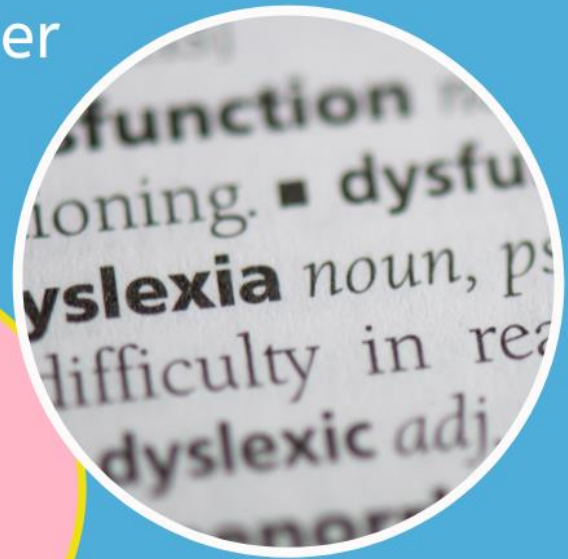
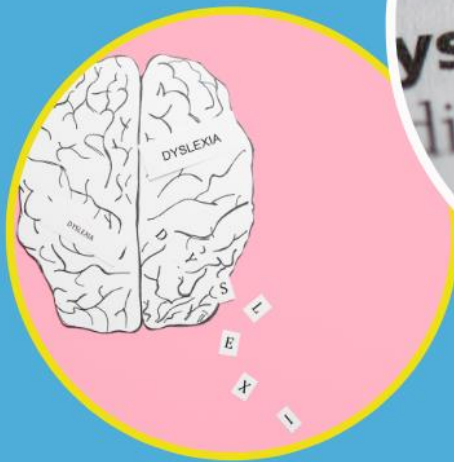
