Cbeebies: Free Apps (free from advertisements and in app purchases)

Go Explore: Early learning skills - Games cover a range of topics from colours, numbers, shapes, speech and language and phonics skills.



Story time - Lots of stories through interactive books. Option to select from two reading modes; children to read independently or with an adult.



Playtime Island - Lots of fun games with favourite Cbeebies characters, learning as they play!



Get Creative: Paint - Open ended creative activities app (draw, paint and doodle). Explore the creative factory to compose own music and to build and bring their own dream toy to life!

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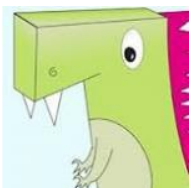
Glow Draw: Drawing - Free App

Great app for children to create their own pictures. They can select their own choice of background and tools to represent their own ideas. Shake to erase!



iPastels: Drawing - Free App

Children can draw own designs and experiment with colour mixing and effects as they blend colours together.



Daisy Dinosaur: Introduction to coding - Free App

This app takes children through step by step instructions, gradually building up to sequences to move 'Daisy the dinosaur'. This is a great app which will support children with their coding skills as they move to using apps such as 'Scratch' in Year 1.



Monster Hunt: Memory Game - Free App

Great for developing attention, concentration and improving working memory skills. Spot where the monsters are hidden and then click on their hiding places. The quicker you find them, the harder it becomes!
