




Things we may talk about: weather, family, home, likes/dislikes, maps, globes, shapes, senses, feelings, Lunar New Year

Literacy: Reading

The children will be introduced to the monsters from our Phonics Foundation Programme linked to Monster Phonics. They will be exposed to 6 aspects of the programme through fun, interactive, games, songs and activities. These include, rhyme, alliteration, sounds in the environment, body percussion and percussion sounds.

Key themes from our texts:

<u>Maths:</u> We will be introducing numbers 1-3, learning to represent each number and practising counting.

We will be learning about size, comparing objects and ordering them by size.

We will also be learning about weight, using language such as heavy, light etc.



Literacy: Writing

We will be learning to make lots of marks in lots of different contexts. We will be working our muscles ready for writing with our funky fingers activities. Our 'squiggle whilst you wiggle' dancing will help us with learning to make marks on paper.

Can you put objects in order of size at home? You could use toys, blocks, books etc.



Physical Development: Gross and Fine Motor Skills

- Funky Fingers using small materials, using scissors to make snips in paper, scrunching, learing, using tweezers and play dough
- Looking at animal positions to help make our bodies stronger.

PE— Gymnastics

 We will be making different shapes, balancing, using equipment, travelling under, over, through and jumping off equipment.



Look at the weather outside. What kind of clothes do you need to wear in hot or cold weather? Can you draw a person wearing these items of clothing?

- Follow routines and instructions

- We will be learning to draw people and practising drawing owls, using step-bystep instructions.
- We will be creating collages and sculptures.
- We will be joining materials to create dragon models.





Please may we ask that:
