

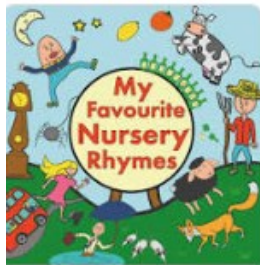
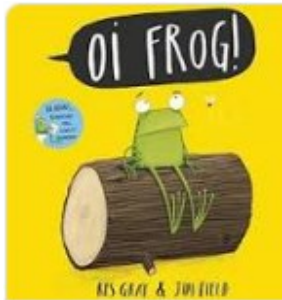

Literacy: Reading
