


Things we may talk about: Spring, caterpillars, butterflies, frogs, growing seeds, plants, changes, 'Jack and the Beanstalk' show

Literacy: Reading

The children will continue to get to know the monsters in our Phonics Foundation Programme linked to Monster Phonics. They will be exposed to 6 aspects of the programme through fun interactive, games, songs and activities. These include, rhyme, alliteration, sounds in the environment, body percussion, percussion sounds.

Key themes from our texts:

- Parts of a plant
- What a plant needs to grow
- Observing changes (tadpole to frog)

Maths:

We will be recapping numbers 1-5, looking at parts of each number and how they are represented.

We will be counting forwards and backwards and looking a one more and one less.



Literacy: Writing

We will be continuing to make lots of marks in lots of different contexts. We will be working our muscles ready for writing with our funky fingers activities. Our 'squiggle whilst you wiggle' dancing will continue to focus on making marks on paper.

Can you create your own pattern at home? You could use loys, cuttery or shoes.

- Funky Fingers using small materials, scissor to make snips in paper, scrunching, learing, using tweezers, and play dough
- Learning animal positions to help make our bodies stronger.
