



Reading

This half term, we will be reading a variety of traditional tales including Rapunzel. We will also be reading stories about Knights and Dragons and looking at information texts about castles, which links to our History topic. Children will be learning to follow and identify features of instructions.

Writing

This half term, we will be writing character descriptions and retelling stories about Knights and Dragons. We will also be writing an alternative version of the traditional tale Rapunzel. We will be learning to recognise features of instructions and writing our own instructions to make a shield.

This half term, the children will learn how to count forwards and backwards in 2s,

5s and 10s, which they will use to develop their multiplication and division skills. In addition to this, the children will learn how to recognise, find, and name a half and a quarter of an object, shape or quantity.

Science

This term, we will be revisiting our learning about materials and making links to our History topic by finding out what castles were built from and their properties. Children will also be carrying out simple experiments to test the properties of different materials.

This half term, we will be learning about algorithms. Children will use a simple computer program to create moving animations.
