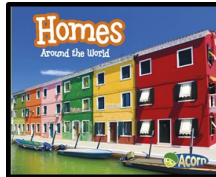
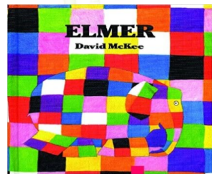


Things we may talk about: Starting school, my family, pets, vets, people who help us, looking after ourselves, exploring and observing our environment, Diwali, Harvest.
