



Nursery Curriculum Overview and Class Routines

Class Expectations

We will expect the children to:

- Be kind with their hands, feet and voices
- Use their manners at all times

PE

Please can we also ask you to check your child's clothing regularly in case they have come home with someone else's or missing some items of their own. For safety reasons, please can all jewellery be removed prior to PE lessons?

Library

Show and Tell

Show and tell sessions will be on Wednesdays and will continue again from next week. Please continue to support your child in sharing items of interest linked to the topic, photographs, pictures they have drawn, books or artefacts.

Reading for pleasure

Reading a bedtime story to your child is an important means of ensuring your child has a love of books and helps develop their vocabulary and language skills. It is also a good way to engage younger siblings and prepare them for nursery and school.

Water bottles, sunhats and sun cream

We are hoping that the weather will warm up this term and the children can make the most of our outside learning area. It is important that your child has a named sunhat and water bottle on the days that it is hot and sunny. Sun cream will need to be applied at home, however, if you feel your child will need it topped up during the day, a named bottle can be sent in which the children will need to apply themselves.
